

What are people reading?


The Long Call Ann Cleeves


Then a face appears from the past - Freddie, her first love, who abandoned her and left her heartbroken 50 years ago.

Recipes:

I'd like to share some easy to follow and lovely to eat recipes from family, friends and colleagues.

Smokey Beans on Toast

This recipe is so quick and easy to make ©

Ingredients:

1 tbsp olive oil

1/2 small onion, sliced

1/2 small red pepper, thinly sliced

1 garlic clove, halved

2 slices smoked streaky bacon, optional

227g can chopped tomatoes

1/2 tsp smoked paprika

2 tsp red wine vinegar

210g can butterbeans or chickpeas, drained

½ tsp sugar

1 slice bread

Parsley sprigs, finely chopped



Method:

- Heat the oil in a small pan
- Add the onion and pepper, bacon (optional) fry gently until soft, about 10-15 mins.
- Crush half the garlic and add this to the pan, along with the tomatoes, paprika, vinegar, beans, sugar and some seasoning.
- Bring to a simmer and cook for 10-15 mins or until slightly reduced and thickened.
- Toast the bread, rub with the remaining garlic and drizzle with a little oil.
- Spoon the beans over the toast,
- drizzle with a little more oil and scatter over the parsley
- Serve immediately




Tuesday: Heist



What to do:


- Roll the socks into balls



fizzle out like Tracy's previous relationships, so is dismayed when her mum decides to marry Sean. They move into his enormous mansion, complete with swimming pool and housekeeper, leaving all that Jess knows and loves behind. Jess is torn: she wants her mum to be happy, but can she learn to like Sean?


It is very good for people who are in foster care.
